Two horse vehicles.—From any place to any other place within the City limits: 1 or 2 persons, \$1, 3 or 4 persons, \$1.50. If to return, add 50 per cent to above rates. It the drive exceeds the hour, hour rates to be charged.

By the hour, for the first hour: 1 or two persons, \$1,3 or 4 persons, \$1.50, each additional hour: 1 or 2 persons, 75 cts., 3 or 4 persons, \$1. Provided always that the rate per day of 24 hours will not exceed \$10.00: \$5.00 for caleche, \$7.50 for wagon, or \$10.00 for a two horse vehicle.
