To Dye Blue—ON WOOL.—For each pound of Wool, take one ounce of Indigo Compound and half an ounce of Alum, dissolve them in a sufficient quantity of hot water, and mix thoroughly; immerse the goods in the dye for ten minutes, stirring well, that it may be evenly coloured; take out and rinse in cold water. If a deep blue is required, use more compound.

Buttermilk Cakes.—Two cups of buttermilk or sour milk, one cup of sugar, one piece of butter the size of a walnut, a teaspoonful of saleratus. Spice to your taste, with as much flour as will make a thin batter, and bake.

CORN FRITTERS.—One teaspoonful of milk, three eggs, one pint of green corn grated, a little salt, and as much flour as will form a batter. Beat the eggs, the yolks and whites separate. To the yolks of the eggs add the corn, salt, milk, and flour enough to form a batter; beat the whole very hard; then stir in the whites and drop the batter, a spoonful at a time, into hot lard, and fry them on both sides of a light-brown colour.

COOKIES.—Two cups of sugar, one cup of butter, half a cup of sour milk, half a teaspoon of soda.

CREAM CAKE.—Beat two eggs in a teacup; fill the cup with thick, sweet cream; add one cup of white sugar, one of flour, one teaspoon of cream-tartar, half teaspoon of soda; bake in long pans.

CIDER CAKE.—Four and a-half cups flour, one and two-third cups sugary, three-fourths cup butter, one and one-third cups cider, one teaspoon soda, one teaspoon cinnamon, one teaspoon cloves.

SUGAR GINGERBREAD.—One quart flour, one cup of shortening (pork-fat and butter) rubbed into the flour, one and a-half cups sugar, one tablespoon ginger, one cup sweet milk, one teaspoon soda.
