I visited the Onion Lake R.C. Residential School on December 23, 1949. The Father Principal was away but I took the matter of Superintendent W. K. Taylor's complaint up with the matter Superior and she informs me that she has notified Mr. Taylor of the children that arrived at the school from Saddle Lake Agency and has also written him giving the names of the children who later came to the school.

She was quite definite in her statement that she does keep each Agency informed of the date of arrival of the students. She further stated that if there is any particular case in which Mr. Taylor might be interested that if he would write them they would give him all information available.
