

McCURE, FIRMAN (*Colchester*).

Family originally from Ayrshire, Scot. Paternal grandfather came to N. S. in early part of the century and settled at West River, Pictou. B., 19 Nov., 1861, at Truro, N.S., and ed. in the public school and the Provincial Normal School there. Graduated in the latter in 1877, and taught school for a few months. M., 23 Oct., 1896, Dora M. Inglis, of Lunenburg. Is a Barrister-at-Law. Has been editor and publisher of Truro *Guardian* for some years; editor of the *Temperance Index* for two years, and Grand Worthy Patriarch of the Sons of Temperance, N.S. An unsuccessful candidate for Colchester in the Commons at g. e., 1896. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at by-election held Aug., 1896. A Liberal.—*Truro, N.S.*

MCCORMICK, JOHN (*Cape Breton*).

Is a general dealer. First returned to Ho. of Assem. at g. e., 1894.—*Sydney Mines*.

McGILLIVRAY, HON. ANGUS (*Antigonish*).

Grandfather, Angus McGillivray, emigrated from Arisaig, Inverness-shire, Scot. B. at Bailey's Brook, Pictou Co., N.S., 22 Jan., 1842. Removed with parents when quite young to Antigonish. M., 5 Feb., 1878, Maggie, dau. of the late Alexander McIntosh, Esq., Antigonish (she d. 8 Sept., 1879); secondly, 15 July, 1884, Miss Doherty of N. Y. Ed. at St. Francois Xavier Coll. there. Called to the Bar of N.S., 22 July, 1874. Is a partner of the law firm of McGillivray & Chisholm. First returned to Ho. of Assem. by acclamation at g. e., 1878, and re-elected at g. e., 1882, and again at last g. e. Was Speaker of the House from Feb., 1883, until the dissolution of the Assembly. Apptd. a mem. of the Ex. Council, 28 June, 1886. Resigned his seat, Jan., 1887, and was an unsuccessful candidate for Antigonish at the g. e. for the Commons, Feb., 1887. Re-elected to Leg. Assem. by acclamation, 1 March, 1887. Re-elected at by-election held 31 June, 1895, and again re-apptd. a mem. of Ex. Council. Re-apptd. a mem. of Ex. Council, 7 March, 1887. A Liberal.—*Antigonish, N.S.*

McKAY, WILLIAM, M.D. (*Cape Breton*).

B. at Earleton, N.S., 11 Sept., 1847. Graduated M.D. at Bellevue Hospital Medical Coll., N. Y., 1873. M., 10 Nov., 1875, Catherine, dau. of Gilbert Sutherland of Colchester, Co. Apptd. 1874 Resident Physician to the Reserve Collieries. Has been Presdt. of the Nova Scotia Medical Soc.
