S. of the late Robt. Colquhoun, of Glasgow, Scot., who came to Am. about beginning of this century, by Elizabeth McNairn, of Cornwall, Ont., the dau. of a U. E. loyalist. B. at Charlottenburg, Ont., 1814. Ed. at Cornwall Grammar Sch. M. 1851, Miss Hester M. Bailey, of Iroquois, Ont. Was Reeve of the Tp. of Osnabruck, and Warden of the united counties of Stormont, Dundas and Glengarry, for some years. Held the office of Postmaster of Dickinson's Landing for twenty-two years. Unsuccessfully contested present seat for L.A., Can., at g. e., 1863. First returned to Parlt. at last g. e.—*Dickinson's Landing, Ont.*
