or otherwise injured, then the Jury on the trial of any such cause may take such facts into their consideration, and if they think it just and equitable, may in consequence thereof find a verdict for the Defendant in any suit 5 so to be brought.

II. And be it enacted, That in any such action may plead the it shall and may be lawful for the Defendant to plead the general issue, and under such plea, on entering a note of this Act in the 10 margin thereof, to avail himself of this Act and of the matters of defence herein given.

To extend only to U. C.

III. And be it enacted, That this Act shall extend to that part of this Province called Upper Canada only. 15
