The Union of the Colony of Vancouver Island with the Colony of British Columbia.

E it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as The British Columbia Act, Short Title. 1866.
- 2. In this Act the Term "Governor" means any Officer for the Interpreta-⁵ Time being lawfully administering the Government.
- 3. The Governor of British Columbia after receiving an Address Proclamafrom the Legislative Council of British Columbia requesting that this Act should be proclaimed by him, and after having been nor, on officially informed that Addresses to the same Effect have been adopted by the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of 10 Vancouver Island, shall proclaim the same accordingly.

4. From and immediately after the Proclamation of this Act by the Governor of British Columbia, the Colony of Vancouver in British Island shall be and the same is hereby united with the Colony Union 15 of British Columbia, and thenceforth those Two Colonies shall form of Vancou-
