

An Act to amend the Act respecting Fisheries and Fishing.

HER MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows: Preamble.

1. The Act respecting Fisheries and Fishing, chapter sixty-two of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada, shall be and the same is amended as follows:

No person shall fish for, catch, or kill any kind of white fish, with seines, in any inland lake in Upper Canada, between the *first day of May and the twentieth day of September* in each year. Taking of white fish.

2. This Act shall be one Act with that hereby amended, and sections 10 thirty-eight to forty-six inclusive of the said Act shall apply to all offenders and offences against this Act. This Act to be one with the Fishery Act.
