The results of a study released last week by UNB's nursing faculty showed an alarming number of pregnant women have tested positive for the AIDS virus.

Four cases of HIV infection were found in the ten thousand women tested. Although this may seem be a very small number, it does mean that New Brunswick has the third highest prevalence of AIDS in pregnant women after Quebec and Newfoundland.

The study was conducted by a disease specialists, clinical microbiologists, epidemiologists, nurses and representatives from AIDS service organizations. Every woman involved in the study took part




