

Malton paperweights win North Bay tourney

Malton Andy's Texacos, runaway titlists of the Mississauga Hockey League's paperweight major division, have won their second tournament in as many tries this season.

With Hank Dixon hitting for a pair of goals, the high-flying Malton crew edged George Bell 2-1 to emerge the proud winner of the annual Ferris Squirt Invitational Hockey Tournament in North Bay.

Twenty-four teams from across Ontario took part in the tourney. Malton, the first

Mississauga team to take the top prize, played in the AA series, beating Don Valley Villagers, 2-0, Etobicoke Canucks, 5-4, and George Bell, 2-1, in that order.

The opening game saw John Vacciarelli set up Mark Piquett for the ice-breaking marker. Later Mark Stephens hit for the insurance point to give Texacos a 2-0 win over Don Valley. Ian Botnick took care of goaltending chores in faultless fashion.

The semi-final against Canucks provided Malton with its toughest hurdle. At

the end of regulation time the two sides were deadlocked 4-4. Mark Stevens scored twice, Danny Davies and Roger Samuel once apiece. The winning goal came in overtime when Hank Dixon converted passes from Stevens and Vacciarelli.

At the end of the tournament, Samuel was named the Most Sportsmanlike Player. It was the second major triumph for the Malton paperweights since the start of the season. In December they also won a trophy at the Hespeler Invitational.
