MR. KING:

Attached is The Journal account of the speech by Mr. Petrucci, the Italian Consul General. A better account appears in The Gazette, and Mr. Henry will have it on your table when you go to Council. He also hopes to have something from Dr. Skelton on the matter.

Mr. Woodsworth proposes to speak in this connection in the House this afternoon and has suggested that it be either by motion to adjourn the House or mention it especially at the time the Douglas resolution is called. He prefers the former, as it would direct more attention.
