with costs against the Plankeff. but Martin has Kept away ever since and Lefort will be comfelled to pay his own costs. (3) Constable Lefort was again arrested on the 10th August on a complaint from Louis Jackson, of Coughnawaga, for having given some intoxicants to one Pierre Onasakete, also an Indian of Carighnawaga, on the 10th fuly last. The case appeared before the Magistrate on the 16th August. The Witnesses: - Louis fackson, the informer, declared that Pierre Onarakete had told hun that Constable Lefort had given him liquor on the 10th July , but Knew nothing more.
