Sir,

I beg to inform you that an Order-in-Council has been passed authorizing the expenditure of \$500.00 from the Capital funds of the West Bay Band to repair the main road from Little Current to Gore Bay, which road passes through their reserve, and is gameral in general used by the Indians.

As soon as you have made arrangements to have the work begun (which it is thought should be done at an early date you may apply for an advance.

You should employ Indians instead of Whitehen as far as is possible upon the work.

A supply of labour return forms will be sent you on which to make out receipted and certified returns in duplicate.
