


initiated by the Provincial authorities is outside the purview of that Department, and that the Minister as such cannot intervene but would interpose no objection if relief can be obtained from any other source.

I am directed by the Superintendent General of Indian Affairs to request that you will be good enough to take immediate steps to secure the release from prison of all the Indians referred to.
