I beg to seknowledge the receipt of your letter of the Sth Ultimo, regarding issue of Lease to the Chalcare Bay Mills, covering land owned by Thomas Condo, on the Restiguishe Indian Reserve, and in reply to say that you should obtain from Condo a written acknowledgment of receipt by him of all rental psyable under lease and forward same to the Department.

In regard to the foregoing, I beg to say that the proper proceeding, as you have already been savised, is for a temant to pay rental to you to be forwarded to the Department, requisiton for the return thereof, in favour of the person entitled to receive sque, to be made by you. Kindly advise all paties into rested that, in future, any moneys paid direct to the Indians, as rental, will not be acknowledge by the Department, thus rentering a temant liable to payment a second time,
