

Ottawa, March 14th., 1940.

Dear Sir:-

I find in August last you were sent an advance of \$15.00 to pay Indians for baskets shipped to Ottawa and sold. An official letter from the Superintendent of Welfare and Training dated August 18th., instructed you how to account for this money and our file would indicate that credit vouchers had not been submitted. Your voucher No. 164 dated August 22nd. is for a similar amount and was paid by cheque No. 462 on September 18th. If this cheque and the advance which was sent you in August covers the same shipment, then you should refund the amount of the advance - \$15.00. If there were two consignments of baskets, then credit vouchers should be submitted covering the advance.

I will be glad to hear from you in this connection by return mail.
