service of the Government represented by the Wartime Information Board. I feel certain that a formula could be devised which would secure a healthy cooperation.

There is only one matter of which I am doubtful. If the situation is as now suggested, and if, because of past history or for one reason or another, the influence of Mr. Phillips is divisive rather than unifying, a cooperative understanding in the matter of information could not be implemented while he remains as a negative force within the set-up.
