- (a) Churches or other religious organizations having an established church or meeting place in the community from which the broadcasts are made.
- (b) Recognized charitable institutions or organizations whose appeals for funds have Federal, Provincial or Municipal endorsation or authorization.
- (c) Universities.
- (d) Musical and Art groups or organizations whose scle aims and objects are other than that of commercial gain.

It was agreed that this matter should be further investigated at the next meeting following an additional report from the Management.
