1.5 <u>Hockey</u> Imperial asking for more facilities in TOR & MTL this year. ACB to be kept informed by all concerned & meeting to be arranged.

1.6 <u>National TV News</u> ACB confirmed affiliates were advised last May that national TV news would be reverting to full length starting Oct. 27th. No other confirmation necessary.

2. Program Reports

2.1 French Networks

2.1.1 <u>Radio & TV General</u> <u>Montreal Municipal Elections</u> Planning to offer locally on CBFT a 10-minute period to each of the 4-5 expected candidates. <u>L'Enfant et les sortilèges</u> Will be produced live again on <u>l'Heure du concert</u>, Dec. 31st. NBC musical director has expressed interest to program producer. J. Dunlop to take up negotiations.

2.2 English TV Network Commercial General Electric Awaiting decision concerning Wayne & Shuster sponsorship in alternance with Showtime.

2.3 English Radio Networks General Revised fall achedule has gone to regions & seems to have been generally well accepted. Royal Visit Special program in preparation for evening of Queen's address. The hour preceding the address will be given to The Age of Elizabeth by Lister Sinclair. G. Waddington looking into possibility of Little Symphonies doing special 9:15-10:00 concert following the address. CBL Morning Scheduling Matter of spot commercials already referred to ACB. All comments to be passed on to SecB. AGM indicated decision affecting Metropolitan Life program requires ample discussion & E. Hallman to note.

- 3. <u>Montreal Reception for Sponsor & Advertising Agencies</u> COM QUE indicated excellent reaction. MGMT asked P&I to explore possibility of holding more receptions of this type, for example, once a year.
- 4. <u>Jonquière Microwave Connection</u> ENG informed by Railways work delayed by construction difficulties & that it would be impossible to make connection at planned date of Sept. 15th. It will now be two weeks before the Railways can announce what new delay would be required.
- 5. <u>Dominion Network</u> Concerning letter received by Ass't ONT from M. Brown of CFPL requesting discussion on future of Dominion Network, MGMT advised CBC would be going through uncertainty period of at least one year & that present plans would be carried on as established with no changes affecting Dominion Network. CFPL should be so informed.
- 6. <u>Audiences</u> AGM asked if in view of special circumstances affecting private stations in TOR & OTT, CBC stations at these points should not try to enlarge their audiences. AGM to follow up with P&I & all concerned.
- 7. <u>Paris Office</u> The General Manager is planning to visit the Paris office on the occasion of his Nov. trip to London in connection with BCINA meeting

& BBC 21st anniversary. CO, ACB & QUE to collect full details on Paris situation for the information of the General Manager.
