

## NEW BRUNSWICK

The upper part of the field shows the English lion, gold, on red field. The remaining part represents a galley symbolic of the maritime interests of this province, and its settlement by the United Empire Loyalists, in 1784, some 40,000 in number.



## MANITOBA

The upper third of the shield shows a red St. George's Cross on a white ground: the remaining portion, a buffalo charging, in gold, upon a green field.
