The ahove are hoifted at the eaff or weft yard-arm, according to the quarter the veffel firf appears in, with the addition of a ball in the centre of the yard, until the veffeis can be feen, when one or more of the following deferiptive colours will be hoifted at the maft-head :-
A Unionfor a flag-fhip, with or without a iquadron.
Do, with a red pendant over it, for a two decker.
Do, with a blue pendant over it, for a Frigate.
Do, with a white pendant over it, for a fmall armed veffel
A red flag, plerced white, for a Packet.
A blue pendant for merchant boip.
A red pendant for a merchant brig.
A white pendant for a topiail floop or fehooner.
A blue and-white flag, hotizoutaliy divided, neutral feet
White-and-blue pendant veutral man of war
Blue flag, neutral merchant thip
A red, white aud b'ue flag, an enemy' fleet
A red, white and blue pendant, an enemy's man of was
A red flag, an encmy's merciastman
An Union Jack over neutral or enemy's fignals, veffel is de. tained, or prize
A white flag over any fignal, vefficl bears a flag of thuce

## SIGNALS OF DISTRESS.

In cafes when immediate affiftance is neceffary, a ball at the maft head, in addition to the defcriptive colours of the veffel in diffrefs; and guis occahonally, until the fignal is attended to.
