An Act to enable the Inhabitants of the feveral Townships within this Province, to Maintain their Poor

Elit enaded, By the Licutenant Gepernor, Council, and Af-Lip. 13. Find y, I hat from and after the Publication hereof, it shall and now be lawful for the Freeholders of any Township within this Province, where there are Fifty or more Families Freeholders refident, to meet on the First Monday in January Annually : Previous Notice being given by the Constables of fuch Townships Respectively (who are hereby required to notify the fame to the Freeholders of each Township, at least Ten Days before the Time of Meeting) of the Time and Place of Meeting in such Township, at which Meeting of the faid Freeholders them and there held, a Chairman being first chosen, the Freeholders thall proceed to choose Twelve Inhabitants of the faid Township, any Nine of which to be a Quorum; who are hereby Impowered to Affeits the Inhabitants of faid Township for fuch Sum, as shall be granted by the faid Freeholders for the Relief of their Poor.

And be it further exacted. That the faid Freeholders in fuch their Annual Meeting, shall be and are hereby Impowered to Vote such Sums of Money as they shall judge necessary for the current Year, to support and Maintain their Poor.

And be it also further enacted. That the Twelve Inhabitants fo elected in the Meeting Annually, or anyNine of them, shall be, and are hereby Impowered to Assess the Freeholders, and other Inhabitants, in Just and equal Proportion as near as may be, for the Monies Voted as aforefaid; and each particular Perion being Assess of the Monies Voted as aforefaid; and each particular Perion being Assess according to his known. Estate, either Real or Perfonal, for the Purpose aforefaid, shall pay the fame to such Perfon or Perfons as shall be appointed to Collect and Receive the same, by the faid elected Inhabitants, or any Nine of them, and if any Perfor to Assess thall Refue or Neglect to pay faid Assessment, the same shall and may be levied by Warrant of Distress, from any One of His Majefty's Justices of the Peace of the Township, or County wherein such Perfon shall refide.

Provided neverthelels, That if anyPerfon shall think himself over Rated, he may Appeal for Redress to the next General Sessions of the Peace of the faid County, and the Justices thereof, are hereby required and Impower'd, to examine, hear, and determine, all and every such appeal or Complaint, and to give Redress, as they in their Judgment shall think equitable, and such their Order and Judgment, shall be Final and Bind all Parties.

And be it enabled, That the Perfon or Perfons appointed to collect the Affeliments aforefaid, finall once in Three Months, Account with and payinto the Hands of the Overfeers of the Poer of faid Township, all fuels furns of Money as he or they may have received, and upon his or their Neglect
