There was a heavy rain and thunder storm in New Brunswick yesterday which resulted in pretty well extinguishing the fire that had been raging for some days.

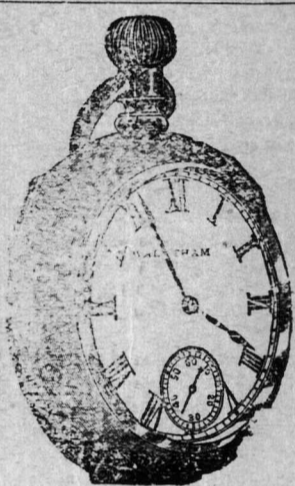

Havana advices of the 20th say that half a dozen prominent leaders of the Liberal party were taken into custody.

The C. P. R. liner Empress of Britain has again cut down the time of crossing the Atlantic.

Two well known and highly respected citizens of Fredericton, N. B., entered the store of a friend a few evenings ago.

John Fraser of North Sydney was found guilty the other day of stealing liquor from a bonded warehouse at that place and sentenced to four years in Dorchester penitentiary.

The business community of Chelsea, Mass., was surprised on Friday when it became known that the First National Bank of that city, one of the oldest institutions in this section of the state had been closed by the Comptroller of Currency.

C. E. Peterson, book-keeper for the G. T. F. construction camp near Winnipeg, appeared to the police at Winnipeg on Friday last to arrest John Butler.

Boston advices of the 18th say — Reports from many cotton mills centres show that in numerous mills the market shortage of help which became apparent last spring still continues.

Valparaiso Destroyed by Earthquake and Fire.

The following intelligence indicates that the destructive work of earthquake and fire is not confined to San Francisco.

Valparaiso, Chile, Aug. 19—At 7.52 o'clock last Thursday evening, Valparaiso experienced an earthquake of great severity.

Most of the damages were due to fire, which started immediately after the first shock.

The captain of a steamship which has arrived from San Francisco says that the situation is worse here than that following the disaster at San Francisco.

Washington, August 19—A despatch to the state department from the American Consul-General at Iquique, reports that Valparaiso is in ruins from an earthquake and is on fire.
