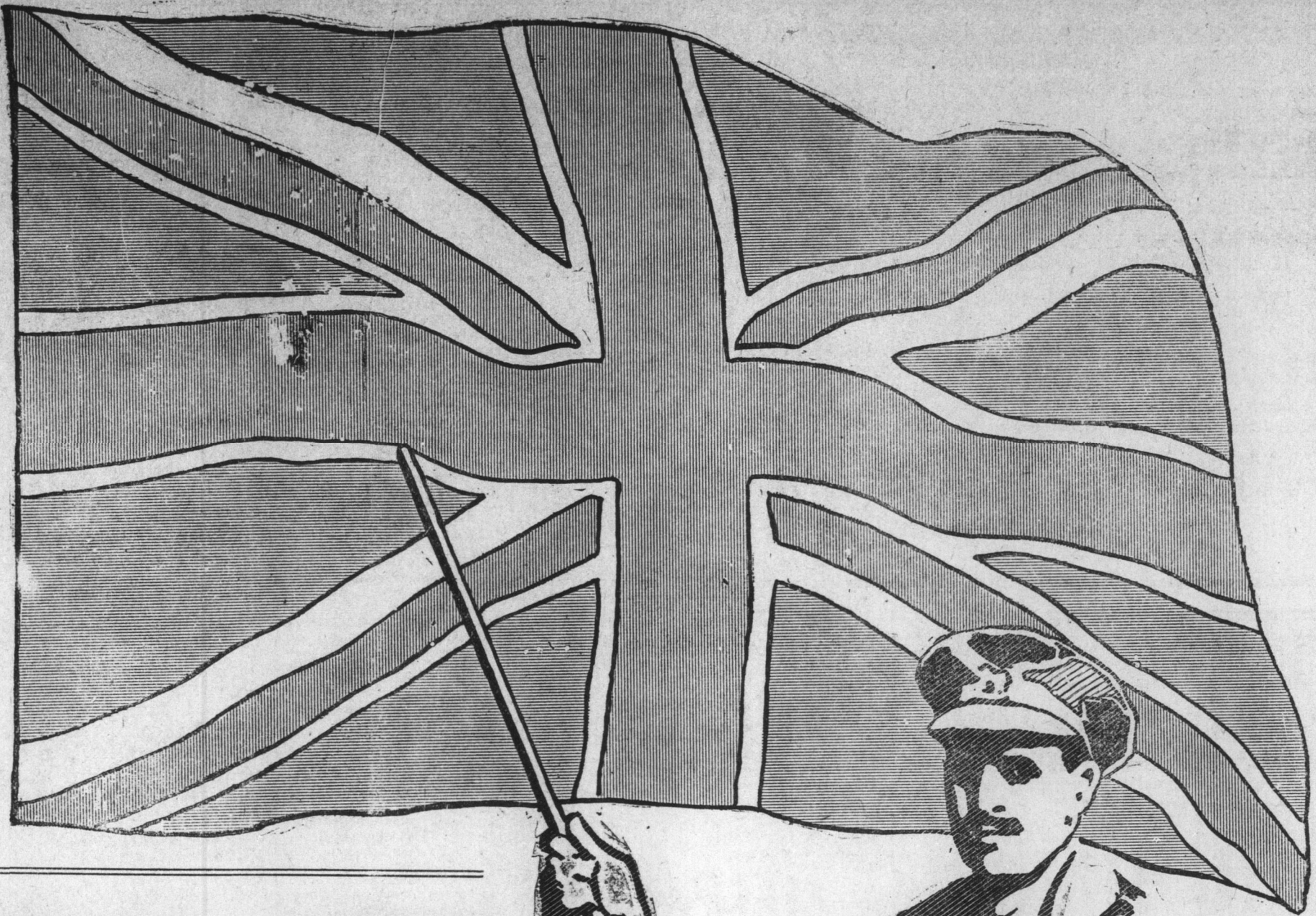


THE Newfoundland Regiment already has won **RENOWN** in Gallipoli and France. Drafts are constantly going to keep up the strength.
