THE ARGUMENT

We propose this policy not as a final one, but as the best possible in our circumstances today, and we advocate it for the following reasons:

1-It is constructive and comprehensive. 2-It is broad in its spirit. 3-It would prevent the dangerous adulteration of liquors.

4-It would give direct government control of a business that should be handled with the utmost care. 5-It concedes to a man his alleged right to take care of his own property.

6-It eliminates the element of private gain, which is responsible for very much of the present evils of the traffic. 7-It would deal with the drunkard not merely in a punitive way, but would seek to make him a useful member of society.

8-It thus makes the business take care of itself, which it creates. At present a few individuals who are immensely wealthy in a business that lays heavy burdens upon the shoulders of poverty, disease, crime and inability.

9-Our contention is, that if we must tolerate such a business, we should purely economic grounds, we should seek to secure the largest district of the province, a number of influential men who will help in obtaining such legislation, and in carrying out the purpose of the law into actual effect.

WINNIPEG WHEAT MARKET SHOWS IMPROVEMENT

On Keen Foreign Demand Prices Advance; Continental Markets Irregular

WINNIPEG, Man., April 7.—The wheat market was generally on the boom today on reports of a keen foreign demand, general bullish feeling and shorts covering, and prices advanced 2-4 to 7-8 for the day.

Livestock closing cables were 1-4 lower to 1-4 higher, while continental markets were irregular. Americans opened 1-8 lower to 1-8 higher, but gradually strengthened.

The cash demand at Winnipeg was fairly good, but very little on offer, and exporters somewhat indifferent. Cash prices advanced to generally on all grades.
