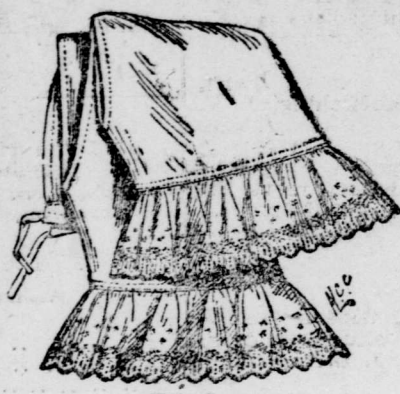

Madrid, Jan. 5.—Queen Regent Christina and the Government have sent messages to Capt. Polavieja, captain-general of the Philippine Islands, congratulating him upon his victory over the insurgents on the heights of Caceron, Province of Bulacan.
