WINNIPEG, July 22.—No break is apparent in the heat wave which is quite general over the western provinces, and high temperatures were reached today at many points. The present week is described as a trying one in Southern Alberta and rain is needed with which it is hoped a crop can be harvested which will be two-thirds as large as that of 1920. LETHBRIDGE, July 22.—Crops in Southern Alberta have withstood a trying week of intense heat and warm winds and a general rain is needed to bring conditions back to approaching normal. Wednesday was the hottest day since 1910. It is estimated that about two-thirds of last year's total will be the best crop that can be expected over the whole of Southern Alberta. This would be only one-third the 1915 crop. In some districts, particularly along the international boundary, crops are still standing up very well, but everywhere rain is needed to keep the fields that are left from going back.




