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DETROIT CAR MEN FACE WAGE CUTS

DETROIT, April 3.—A wage cut affecting approximately 3,500 motor-

men and conductors is proposed by the Detroit United Railway Company, it was announced here today, and representatives of the employees have been called into conference Thursday, when the matter will be taken up.

Officials of the traction company said the amount of the cut had not been determined. The present wage agreement expires May 1, and the advance notices of the proposed cut is in conformity with the contract under which the men work.
