Cleanliness In Dairying.
Ottawa, Jan. 10.—At the Eastern Dairy men's convention to-day G. A. Putman, superintendent of dairying, urged the importance of efforts which would induce the producer to exercise the greatest possible care in dairying. An authority had declared that the infant raised upon the average milk delivered in the city stood only one chance out of fifteen for life, compared with the infant raised in the natural way.

Box Cars Threatened.
Regina, Sask., Jan. 11.—The stock of food in Hanley on the Prince Albert branch of the Canadian Northern will soon be exhausted unless shipments can be got in, and so serious is the fuel famine that farmers, according to reports, are tearing down their barns for firewood. A merchant from there who reached here to ask for government relief, says people in Hanley threaten to burn the box cars on the sidings.

Love Lozenges Poison.
Madoc, Ont., Jan. 11.—A young fellow, Marmora Haggerty by name, who lives 30 miles north of here, near Gilmour, was poisoned by eating "conversation" lozenges. Three Madoc doctors were called in attendance, and by their combined efforts he succeeded in recovering from the effects of the poison. It is time, however, that the government inquired a little more closely into the manufacture of this cheap confectionery. Cases of poison from this cause are becoming so common as to give cause for alarm.

Yankees Loyal to Canada.
Winnipeg, Man., Jan. 11.—Members of different American associations are resenting the expressions in British papers about American immigration being a menace to British supremacy in the west. They point to the fact that while there are German, Canadian, Icelandic-Canadian, and Galician Canadian political clubs in the west demanding recognition for their candidates, there is not one single American political club, and the only organization among the Americans is a sporadic social organization in a few localities which celebrates the Fourth of July. Americans are claiming recognition as liberals and conservatives only.

Big Detroit Blaze.
Detroit Jan. 8.—A general alarm was turned in to-night for a fire at the Michigan Stove Works, one of the largest manufacturing establishments in the city. At 9 p.m. President Geo. H. Barbour estimated the loss at \$500,000; insurance \$380,000. Several firemen and half a dozen spectators were injured. The fire was under control at 9 o'clock.

LOCAL OR OTHERWISE.
The date for the opening of the Ontario Legislature has been set for Jan. 24th. The first ship loaded with Salvation Army immigrants for Canada will leave England Feb. 13th. Majority Favors Local Option.
Toronto, Ont., Jan. 11.—The efforts of the local optionists seem at last to be bearing fruit in the vote at the recent elections on that issue are any indication. The supporters of this measure anticipated victory in at least 50 per cent of the municipalities voting. The more sanguine ones were even more confident. The result, however, cannot but be satisfactory to the temperance workers, while in many cases the vote offers a grain of comfort to the opponents of the measure. One hundred and eleven municipalities in Ontario voted on local option, and of the number already heard from probably 40 per cent have endorsed the measure. In many other cases a majority was given but this proved ineffective, owing to the three-fifths vote required under the provision of the new act.
