Visit of the Papal Delegate.

On Monday evening, May 15th, the faculty and students of the University were highly honored by a visit from His Excellency the Most Reverend Peregrine Stagni, O.S.M., D.D., the newly appointed Apostolic Delegate to Canada. His Excellency arrived quietly at the University in the afternoon and received a welcome from the Very Rev. Rector and several members of the faculty previous to the reception held later in St. Joseph's Church.
