Stock Exchange Notes.—The Stock Market has been firm during the past fortnight and the demand for investment securities is good. The reduction of the Bank of England rate has encouraged speculation, and the ease in the local money market has helped. A large business has been done in stock of the People's Heat & Light Co. of Halifax, which was listed two days ago. The stock of the company advanced from 44½ to 54½. Canadian Pacific has shown buying orders in consequence of very good traffic receipts.
