

new constitution allowed every man the free exercise of his religion, in future no one should be obliged to display either tapestry or leaves and flowers before his house; that the National Guard could not be put in requisition for any religious ceremonies, and that no citizens could be compelled to close their shops as the procession passed.

It was also said the the émigrés were returning to Paris in thousands; that they held secret meetings there, and that we should have very bad news.
