

watered before the commencement of a match, till it is of the required consistency.

3. After each player has pitched his quoits fifteen times at each end, the motts shall be shifted to new ground, or whenever in the opinion of the referee, the ground has become too much broken up.

MEASUREMENT.

1. Measurement shall be from the centre of mott to the nearest visible part of quoit.

2. Before measurement is made, no obstructions of earth shall be removed, except what can be removed, by either the player or his director, blowing with his breath three times.

FURTHER PROVISIONS.

Should any questions arise, the determination of which is not provided for, by the words and spirit of the rules now established, it may be referred to the Executive Committee.
