Tenders will be received by the undersigned till SATURDAY 26th NOVEMBER inst. at 12 o'clock noon, to furnish 24,500 feet of good sound Hemlock Plank, 16 feet long and 3 inches thick, 355 pieces of Cedar, 16 feet long and 6 inches at small end, 65 pieces of Cedar 16 feet long and 10 inches at the small end, 80 pieces of Cedar, 16 feet long and 12 inches at the small end. The whole to be good, sound and straight, no second growth, and any additional quantities that may be required at the same rate, the whole to be delivered by April 1, 1899, at the undermentioned places :
