

# Golf Fine Score By New Champion

## ALBERT MURRAY GOLF CHAMPION

Burk of Fort William and Thompson of Hamilton are Tied For Second Place.

MONTREAL, Aug. 15.—(Staff Special.)—Albert Murray, the popular young professional of the Kanawaka Golf Club, won the Canadian open golf championship here today by maintaining his consistent and deadly game, which he has shown throughout the other three rounds. His final round saw him come home in the lowest score of the tournament, namely, 72, and incidentally capture the lowest score prize also. This is the second time that this spectacular young golfer has captured this coveted title, as in 1909, he captured it at Ottawa. Jack Burk of Fort William and Nichol Thompson of Hamilton tied for second place, and both men returned good cards. Burk finished in 74, and Thompson in 75, making their grand total 201 for the four rounds. Both men played masterful long games and were fair on the greens. Davey Blair of Ottawa, who won the Canadian professional tournament last Tuesday, was third, with 82. He fell away in the final round, as a 77 was the best he could do. His 74 in the morning was a good card, however. Arthur Woodward of St. Lambert, who captured fourth honors, played very steady golf as his four cards show. They were as follows: 77, 75, 77, 75, making a total of 304.

**Champion's Card.**

## THREE FREIGHT CARS RUN AMUCK

## BURNS WINS FROM MAYES ALLEN LOSES TO BAIRD

Mayes is an extremely steady player, but Burns was deadly in his smashing, and his passing shots, with Mayes at the net, were simply magnificent. Some of his hand drives brought the gallery to its feet, and generally he played the most aggressive and brilliant game yet seen in the tournament.

The other semi-final, between Baird and Allen, was another interesting game. Baird played good all-round tennis and came thru in straight sets. Allen, who was the final stage, Burns and Mayes, was very accurate. The doubles championship also advanced. Burns defeated Glasco and Smart in a well-contested game, and then won from Allen and Mayes in another great match. It was the superiority of the winners' overhead that settled it. Rose pulling off many brilliant smashes. Allen, former American champion, showed splendid generalship, and Burns was very accurate, but the hard-hitting Toronto Club men were not to be denied.
