

THE HOUSE OF COMMONS OF CANADA.

**BILL 17.**

An Act to amend the Criminal Code.

**H**IS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

**1.** Section one of chapter forty-six of the statutes of 1919, being an Act to amend the *Criminal Code*, is hereby repealed. 5

**2.** Section four of the said Act is repealed and section one hundred and thirty-three of the *Criminal Code*, chapter one hundred and forty-six of the Revised Statutes, 1906, is hereby re-enacted. 10

**3.** Section five of the said Act is repealed and section one hundred and thirty four of the *Criminal Code* is hereby re-enacted.
