### WILL MAKE SHELL STEEL AND NOT MUNITIONS

The Dominion Steel Corporation is devoting particular attention to the production of shell steel, which is in such active demand, and is leaving the turning out of shells to the other companies. The management went into the matter of shell output with the old shell committee, but did not see its way clear to take on the heavy capital outlay incident to taking on shell production as well.

It is stated in steel circles that further foreign orders, particularly Russian, are now available, if the Canadian mills can give any guarantee of being able to make deliveries as required.

CYANIDE AT DOME LAKE.

SOUTH PORCUPINE, Nov. 22.—By changing the gold extraction system from the old amalgamation process to cyanide, it is expected a greater recovery will be made at the Dome Lake mill. The cyanide equipment is now being added.
