



THE CURLIEST LAMB BORN.

Full-blood Karakul lamb four days old. The father is Teddy senior, the property of the Middle-water Cattle Company; the mother is a full-blood Karakul ewe, but has some fine wool in her fleece. Little of this is evident in the lamb, however, bearing out Dr. Young's contention that a small amount of fine wool in the ewe can be neutralized by a prepotent, decidedly coarse-wool ram.
