

CONDUCT TURF AFFAIRS IN ENGLAND SAME NEXT YEAR AS THE LAST SEASON

Jumping Races Being Carried On Under Somewhat Difficult Conditions—Hard to Reach Tracks.

London, Jan. 5.—Quite naturally, matters to talk about among turfmen have been sparse since our restricted flat racing season came to an end with the final race of the Newmarket thoroughbred meeting. It is true that following the winter months will have the pleasure of witnessing their favorite sport at a limited number of cross-country meetings, occurring now and then throughout the winter, but the great body of patrons of racing, and most of the "illegitimate" meetings, owing to military exigencies and restrictions to military exercises and restrictions, it follows that they will be conducted with small prospects of any notable profit, and in some cases there is foreknowledge of a certain loss. Even so, the pressing necessity of providing recreation for men and horses overhauled other considerations, and the officials of the courses where the winter season of racing is permitted take their chances manfully, confident of better results after the end of the war.

In such of these meetings as have been held, there has been a certain amount of success and some excellent performances have been recorded. Proposed Amendments To the Rules of Racing

New York, Jan. 4.—The amendments to the rules of racing, which will be acted upon at the annual meeting of the Jockey Club on Jan. 11, 1917, contain many changes in respect to definitions and interpretations, while a number of additional clauses are inserted to cover situations not provided for in the old rules. Here are some of the proposed changes and additions:

A horse is "bred" at the place of his birth.
An untitled horse is one whose produce are maidens.
A match is a race between two horses the property of different owners, on terms agreed upon by them, and to which no money or prize is added; it is void if either party dies.

An overnight race is a race for which the entries close forty-eight hours or less before the time set for the first race of the day on which such race is to be run.
To remove the mandatory of the punishment of the Jockey Club, one of the rules relating to the regulation of meetings was changed. The new rule gives the power to treat leniently with men who violate the rules. The old rule makes it necessary for them to rule off any person concerned in any fraudulent practices on the turf. Hereafter they will have all their former power and permission to "otherwise less severely punish."

BEST HORSES FOR ST. THOMAS RACES

St. Thomas, Jan. 4.—George S. McCall, secretary of the St. Thomas Racing Association, has returned from Toronto with assurance that all of the speedy horses participating in the races there will come direct to St. Thomas for the big meeting on Jan. 17, 18 and 19.
