Business of the House

Mr. Goodale: Mr. Speaker, as indicated earlier in the day by the government House leader, tomorrow we intend to begin with Bill C-6 dealing with diplomatic immunities. We have adopted the necessary motion to bring that legislation back from the standing committee so it can be dealt with tomorrow on the floor of the House. After concluding Bill C-6 we intend to move to Bill S-3, dealing with the Deposit Insurance Corporation and conclude third reading. We will then move to Bill C-36 dealing with motor vehicle safety, and Bill C-40, the aeronautics legislation. I believe there is a disposition in the

House to proceed with both those items through all stages, or at least as far as through to third reading stage.

Mr. Goodale: We will consider that, Mr. Speaker.
