MONTREAL, May 9.—In spite of the denunciation of the clergy, the Parnellite delegates collected one hundred and fifty dollars more than Parnell himself did when he visited Montreal.

A writ of mandamus was granted this morning to compel the Grand Trunk Railway to receive freight tendered by the New Ontario express company.

A petition signed by sixty-five cattle exporters from all parts of the Dominion, including Senator Cochrane, will be forwarded to Minister Carling asking the government to limit the space to 2 feet inches by 8 feet clear.
