

APPENDIX TO REPORT No. 1, OF COMMITTEE ON LAWS OF SUBORDINATES.

COMMITTEE ROOM, CHATHAM,
AUGUST 7th, 1862.

To the R. W. Grand Lodge of Canada West.

We your committee appointed on Laws of Subordinates, having carefully examined the laws laid before us, beg leave to report as follows :

Your committee having minutely examined and criticised the By-laws of Eureka Lodge, No. 30, situated at London, C. W., find them correct, and in strict accordance with the Constitution.

Your committee regret to inform you that Erie Lodge, No. 33, have not yet corrected their Constitution and By-laws, condemned by your Grand Body at the session held at St. Catharines, in 1860.

We also recommend that Chatham Lodge, No. 29, strike out from the title pages of their Constitution and By-laws the words, "British North America," and insert the words "of Canada West," and in conclusion we respectfully submit the following resolutions :

Resolved,—That the By-laws of Eureka Lodge, No. 30, situated at London, C. W., be adopted by this R. W. Grand Lodge.—Carried.

Resolved,—That the words "British North America," be erased from the title pages of Chatham Lodge, No. 29, and that the words "Canada West" be inserted thereon.—Carried.

Resolved,—That the Grand Secretary be instructed to call the attention of Erie Lodge No. 33, to the subject referred to in your committee's report.—Carried.
