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THE FACTS ABOUT THE GRINDSTONE ISLAND LIGHT

Another Case where Corre-
spondence to the Telegraph
Aims to Discredit Department
of Marine and Fisheries.

"The Telegraph in recent issues has
been publishing letters which tend to
throw discredit on the Department of
Marine and Fisheries in regard to the
efficiency of the light and service on
Grindstone Island. The Telegraph
has published statements which
alleges that the island is
"Shrouded in darkness, no move-
ment made to complete it and show the
satisfactory manner where the island
lies."

"A common barnyard lantern was
hung on a pole;
"for nearly two years practically
unlighted."
"The department is referred to
"did not make any move to re-
medy the evil;"

"It appears to have been a matter
of days until an efficient light could
have been maintained."

As is known the lantern on Grind-
stone Island was destroyed by fire in
January, 1911, at about the close of
navigation at that point. Immediately
after navigation opened a 250 de-
gree lens lantern of the seventh order
was placed on the old tower; the
glass in the tower had been destroyed
and the lens lantern at its elevation
could be seen at least eight miles. The
light is similar too, to that used at
Rock's Point or Cumberland Basin,
passed by as many vessels going to
die coal mines, etc. In one week as
would pass Grindstone Island in a
month.

The old government had given an
order for a new lantern which, when
installed, will be one of the finest in
the bay. The present department has
allowed the contract to stand in order
to favor a Canadian company in pre-
ference to a foreign company as here-
tofore, and expected the arrival of the
lantern in time for the opening of
navigation the past season. Strikes
among the millers and iron workers
retarded the work of the company with
the result that the government has
been disappointed repeatedly throughout
the past summer. The new light will
be a revolving one capable of being
seen at a distance of 15 miles in
