A R T I C L E III.

Concerning fines
exceeding ten
shillings.

And be it further enacted by the same authority, That when the fine shall exceed ten shillings, the court of field officers shall consist of the colonel, lieutenant-colonel, and major, and in case of the absence of any of them, of the officers next in rank.

A R T I C L E IV.

And in order to explain in a clearer manner the times of review fixed by the same ordinance, as well as to anticipate the particular circumstances that may require them,

Be it therefore enacted by the said authority, That the militia shall assemble and be reviewed one day in every month from the first day of May to the thirtieth day of September, and at such other times as the commander in chief shall think necessary.

Insulting an of-
ficer or sergeant
in the execution

Be it further enacted, That whoever shall quarrel, or insult by abusive words, or otherwise, an officer
