Motion for third reading; Amendment moved to recommit the Bill for the purpose of amending the same; Negatived; Bill read third time and passed, 320. Senate agrees, 358. R. A., 440. (46 Vic., c. 7.)

2. House agrees to go into Committee to consider certain proposed Resolutions respecting "The Canada Civil Service Act, 1882"; His Excellency's recommendation signified, 125.
