 granted to the Nation by Limits 7th March
 1742 under condition that should the
 Indians abandon their village ^{at} of Lorette, change
 their religion or be persecuted in any other manner
 that they then were, it should revert to
 the Crown. Object of limits to induce
 Indians to continue residence at Lorette. Stated in
 deed of donation. Land solely for use of In-
 dians living in Lorette. Difficulties settled
 by Chiefs and Indians with approbation of Indian
 Judiciary. Chiefs determine that when any
 Indian removes from village he ceases to have
 as right to any benefits from lands.
 The two Barthelemy attended enquiry on 9th
 November 1843 duly informed of change
 by Chiefs and promised to withdraw from
 land in ensuing spring.
