Tovernog Sound Head induced the Indians to remove to the Maintoulin Islando, one of the implied inducements consisted of the fisheries around that group, which resources would afford their some means of sub = sistenes; and that this, taken in conjunction of the terms of the Treats of 1836 furted in your letter of 8th March last, creates lan absolute right to these fisheries which the Indians would require to peaceably "surender whally or in part as a territorial possession before the public can exercise any control over than. The same letter states that the proposal of white fishermen to occupy
