

Manatowauing 4th Feb^y 1842

Sir,

I have the honor to inform you that I have received letters from Mr. James Morrison and Stephen Jeffery who tell me that you have referred them to me on the subject of entering into a contract for the Building of Twenty five Indian Houses at this place. As I am not authorised to enter into any contract and have no instructions from you on the subject, I have recommended their sending to you Tenders for the work, mentioning in the tenders that they will conform to the Agreement entered into & have been entered into by James Warren last Autumn (excepting the price, and I would beg to name Jeffery as the most competent person).

In my Requisition of the 1st ult^o I omitted 150 Bushels of Indian Corn and 300 pounds of Tallow which I will thank you to add.
