Ottawa, November 19, 1908.

Sir, I have to inform you that Joseph Chebenay, to whom a Commission was issued by you in September,
1900, as constable for the Parry Island reserve, is now
living at Henvey Inlet and his services as constable are
not now available for the former place.

I have therefore the honour to request that a Commission be issued in favour of Phillip Menominee, who has been recommended for the position of constable to replace Chebenay.

The Indian Agent reports that the condition of affairs on the reserve is such that the services of a constable are immediately required.

An effort will be made to obtain the Commission issued to Chebenay.
