Sir,—

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 8th. inst., enclosing a complaint made by four members of the band against Councillor Andrew Maracle.

In reply, I have to request that you will inform Councillor Maracle of the complaint made against him, and warn him that, if at the end of two months after you have so notified him, there should ^{not} be reason to believe that he had reformed in his habits, the Department will feel bound to recommend that he be deposed from office; and you might point out to him that, in the event of his being deposed, he would not be eligible for election at the next election, to be held within about a year from now.
